Erna Schein Handcrafted Wines

Erna Schein is a boutique winery in the truest sense. Owned by Les Behrens and Lisa Drinkward, who've made wine under the **Behrens & Hitchcock** label since 1993, Erna Schein produces small lots of six or seven wines a year at its winery perched high on top of Spring Mt Napa Valley. Each wine is a low tech labor of love: crushed into one-ton T-bins, punched down by hand, gently transferred to barrel, and bottled unfinned and unfiltered. One only has to look at Les and Lisa's hands during harvest to know their wines are truly "hand-crafted."

'Cemetery' Cabernet Sauvignon, 2006

Varietal/Vineyard: 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Petite Verdot, 7% Cabernet Franc, 6% Merlot/ David Abreu's Vineyard, Napa Valley

Winemaker: Les Behrens

Quik Facts: The 2006 Cemetery again comes from one of our favorite 'plots' in St. Helena. The wine exudes aromas of coffee, violets, earth and minerals. With a dark garnet color and a brooding but balanced richness. Silky tannins lead to focused flavors of raspberry cordial, cassis and smoky spice. It's to die for! 370 Cases

'Blender Boy', 2007

Varietal/Vineyard: 63% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 11% Petite Verdot, 7% Syrah, 4% Cabernet Franc

Quik Facts: Yep, Les has done it again, and we hope he never stops! Like The Kitchen Sink and Spare Me before this, Blender Boy is Les' latest inspired concoction. 285 cases.

'Jersey Boy', 2006

Varietal/Vineyard: 46% Syrah, 34% Merlot, 13% Cabernet Franc, 7% Petite Verdot/Napa Valley

Quik Facts: The 2006 Jersey Boy is a spicy and complex follow up to the inaugural 2005. As with the 2005, this wine comes primarily from the famed Alder Springs Vineyard, with just a touch of Petite Verdot from Kenefick Ranch. 330 Cases

'Spare Me', 2006

Varietal/Vineyard: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc/Napa Valley

Quik Facts: Although it says Cabernet Sauvignon on the label, the 2005 Spare Me hints at greater complexity than just a single grape. Partnered with Merlot and Cabernet Franc, the wine is a dark crimson and boasts a nose both precise and inviting.

'Everything But.....The Kitchen Sink', 2006

Varietal/Vineyard: 44% Syrah, 29% Petite Sirah, 17% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot/Napa Valley

Quik Facts: True to its name the 2006 Kitchen Sink is a creative blend of various lots which come together to make a beautifully balanced wine. 395 Cases

'Knock Out', 2006

Varietal/Vineyard: Cabernet Sauvignon /Napa Valley

Quik Facts: Dare we say, the Knock Out delivers a powerful 1 - 2 punch. Up front, this wine is big and bold with aromas of all spice and clove. Round 2: the mid-palate is thick with flavors of chocolate, blueberries, espresso and plum cake. 350 cases

'Front Man', 2005
